

Please note the following changes in the Chambers County Student Code of Conduct for the 2008-2009 school year.

Page 14 Violation number 13

Possession of electronic devices

Change the disposition to:

- 1st offense: One to three days ISS, Saturday Detention, and/or Extended Work Assignment.
- 2nd offense: One day out of school suspension.
- 3rd offense: Two days out of school suspension.
- 4th and subsequent offenses: 10 days ISS or 45 Days NDLC assignment. **With each offense the principal shall return the phone to the parent no earlier than the end of the school day of the offense.**

Page 14 Violation number 13

Dress Code Violation: "Busting Slack and/or inappropriate showing of skin". Students who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed in class.

Change the disposition to:

- 1st offense: One to three days ISS, Saturday Detention, and/or extended work assignment.
- 2nd offense: One day out of school suspension.
- 3rd offense: Two days out of school suspension.
- 4th and subsequent offenses: 10 days ISS or 45 Days NDLC assignment.

Page 17

Bus Violations and Sanctions

- a. Each student will sit in his/her assigned seat.
- b. Boys and girls will sit on separate sides of the bus.
- c. Students are responsible for damage to the seat they are assigned or any other seat they choose to occupy.
- d. Elementary students will sit in front seats unless the driver deems it necessary to move them.
- e. The driver will ensure that students sit in assigned seats and remain in them while on the bus.
