The Alabama Technology Education Course of Study is the very first Course of Study containing technology education content standards for students in Grades K-8. It addresses the goal of all students being technology literate by the end of eighth grade. The Alabama State Board of Education, in adopting the technology education course of study, fully expects usage in all Alabama public schools. Beginning with the 2003 - 2004 academic year implementation of this course of study was added to the comprehensive monitoring document. In grades 9-12, the Computer Applications content standards must be taught in a separate course, although systems are encouraged to continue to integrate technology into all courses in all grades.

The purpose of the Technology Education Course of Study is to provide a foundation for technology literacy for all students. This foundation includes both knowledge and skills necessary for navigating the challenges of technological advances facing students who are preparing to live and work in the 21st century. The Lesson Plans provided here are samples that have been created by the Madison County TECOS Team and/or selected from the Internet and modified specifically for each grade level to use in the implementation of the Technology Education Course of Study.
