On Tuesday, March 16th, juniors will have the opportunity to take the Early Assessment Program (EAP) English Writing test. The EAP is an opportunity for students in grade 11 to obtain information about their readiness for college-level English. One of the benefits of this program is earning an exemption from the CSU English placement test upon admission to the CSU, as well as for English placement at the California Community Colleges.

Students currently enrolled in English will take it during their English class. Those students who took English in the fall will take the test in the cafeteria during 2nd period. A notice will be delivered to each junior letting them know what time they will report to the cafeteria. The test will last approximately 45 minutes.
