Freshman Academy Orientation Process 2010

January 21, 2010: Selected LCHS students will visit LCMS to speak to eighth grade students about their own personal experiences through the transition process. They will give advice about how to make ninth grade a success and can answer questions to reduce the anxiety of making the transition from middle school to high school.

January 25, 26, 2010 @ 6:00pm in the LCHS Auditorium: Parent Nights; Parents and their rising ninth grader can attend either night and will learn information to help their child be successful in high school. Important information to help students register for high school courses will also be provided.

January 30, 2010 from 11:00am-1:00pm: Freshman Festival at LCHS; This event will provide parents and students the opportunity to visit the high school campus, learn about high school extracurricular activities, participate in a pep rally, as well as a free hot dog lunch cooked by the LCHS cafeteria staff. All eighth grade students who attend may sign-up for a free freshman t-shirt and will also earn a Saturday School credit for the middle school. A class ring and yearbook will also be given away.

February 8, 9, 10, 2010: Visitation by LCHS counselors Mary Smith and Edna Chisena to LCMS with information in regards to the pre-registration process. During this time pre-registration forms will be sent home with each student to choose courses for their ninth grade year.

February 12, 2010: Pre-registration forms due back to LCMS (to the students social studies teacher).

May 3, 5, 10, 2010: LCMS students will visit LCHS where they will participate in a high school lesson and also visit certain areas of the school.
