Master schedule has daily time devoted to social emotional learning as tier 1 instruction.2. Lincoln Pennies will be used to reward positive behavior of individuals.3. Student of the Month Program based on the monthly character education traits from Core Essentials.4. More structure during recess time to reduce opportunities for disagreements.5. Implementation of the PBIS strategies for building-wide expectations and incentives.6. Assemblies will be provided to promote character education.
Reading Improvement	77.5% of the students tested in reading on the 2010 ISAT will score in the meets or exceeds category!	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Staff development will be provided on teaching reading strategies.2. Additional instruction in literacy will be given to the students who are tier 2 or tier 3.3. Accelerated Reader will be used to encourage and reward reading for pleasure.4. Small group instruction will be provided at the student's reading level.5. Students will receive 90 minutes of direct instruction (tier 1).6. Provide opportunities for students to read texts they will encounter after school (internet, newspaper, periodicals, etc.)7. Teachers will utilize the services and instructional expertise of the Literacy Coach (Lani Meleski).8. Teachers will streamline intervention process by analyzing the MAP results for their students.9. Use of Direct Instruction materials with select students or classes.
