Box of Kleenex (**9-1/2" x 4-3/4" x 3-1/4"**)

Paint shirt

School bag, durable (large)

5 - Two-pocket folders, durable, (**horizontal pockets**)

Flashcards (**subtraction - Make sure they go beyond 12, up to 18-9=9**)
