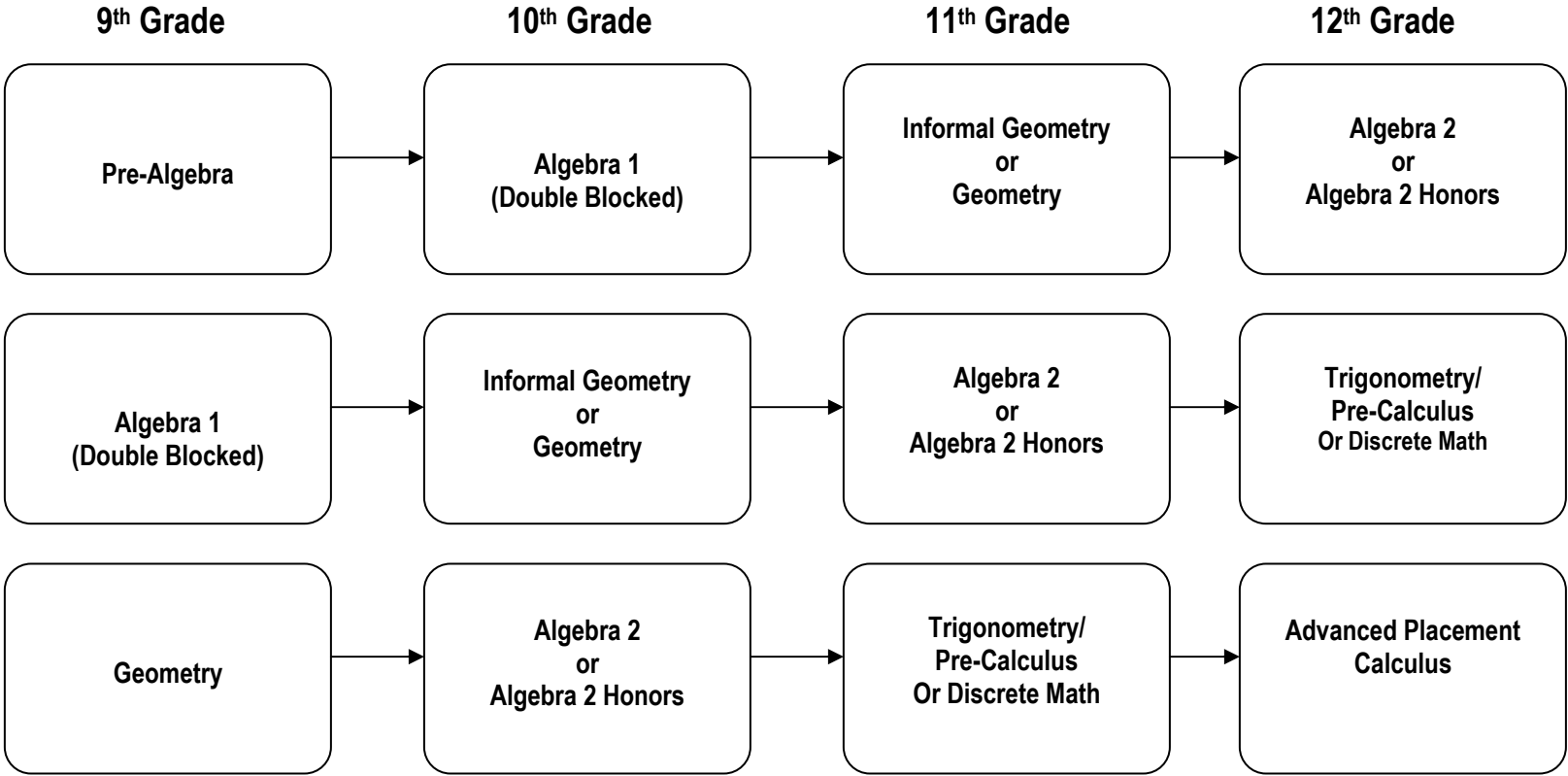

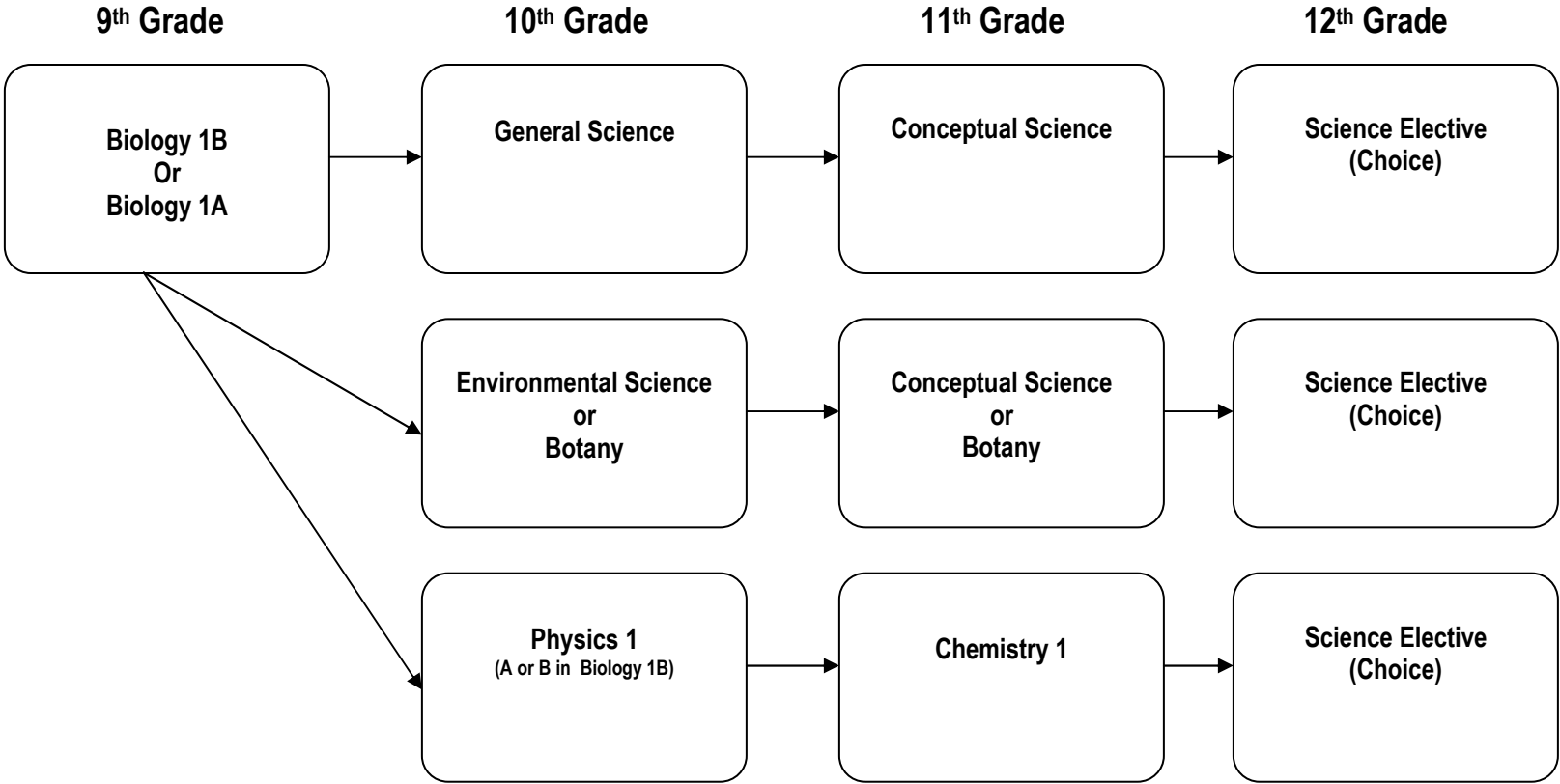

Suggested Course Sequence**



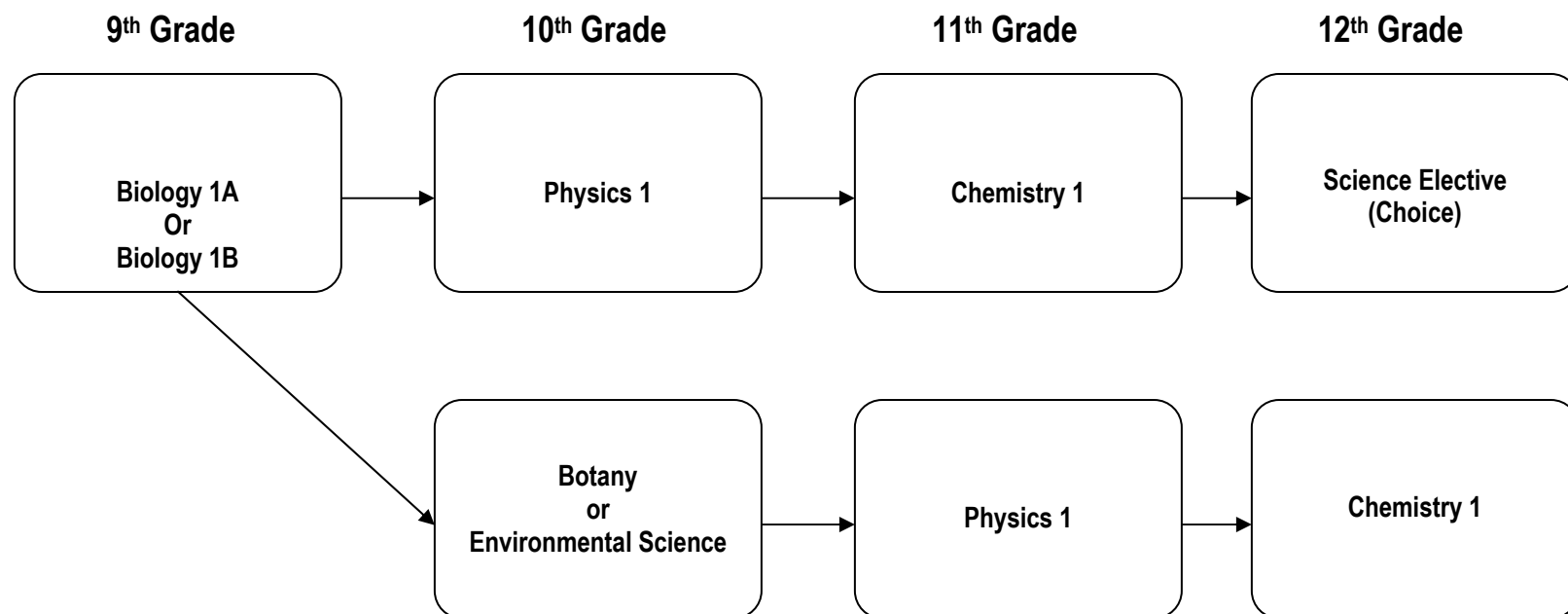
MHS Science Department Suggested Course Sequence
