PBIS Secondary Team

The Secondary team works with teachers to help students adopt acceptable behaviors when Universal interventions have not succeeded. After an initial request is made, a member of the Secondary team and the classroom teacher will meet to work on a Tier 2 behavior intervention for students.

- **HUGS (Hello, Update, Goodbye) is the first step for Tier 2 behavior interventions (standard protocol). Though the time frame may be slightly adjusted for changes in goals (mutually agreed on by teacher and team), six weeks of the HUGS program being done consistently with integrity will be the “rule of thumb.”**
- **If the HUGS program on its own is not resulting in a significant change in the target behavior, the Secondary team will recommend the student become part of a *Second Step* group. The student will meet in small groups with other students for the purpose of instruction and discussion related to acceptable behaviors using the *Second Step* curriculum.**
- **If after students complete the first phase of the *Second Step* program (in 07-08 this was 9 weeks), and progress is not acceptable as defined in conjunction by the classroom teacher and team, a recommendation for a **Functional Behavior Analysis** will be made. Depending on the results, the team *may* recommend moving to the individual Student Support Team Process if additional small group interventions are not available that meet the behavioral needs for this student.**
