

White Oak High School Campus Parking Regulations

1. A student must be eligible to purchase a parking pass at the time of the request.
2. Parking pass eligibility is determined by presenting the following information to the office: signed and dated WOHS Campus Parking paperwork, a valid NC Driver's license, a valid vehicle registration form in the student's name or the name of a parent, guardian, or other person that has presented a notarized letter giving the student permission to drive the vehicle, clearance of school fees: textbook, media, athletic, band, clubs, or monies owed to the cafeteria.
3. The parking pass must be purchased prior to parking a vehicle on campus.
4. The parking pass must be hung on the rear view mirror with parking spot number facing out. The pass must be visible.
5. The parking pass will be assigned to a reserved number in a designated parking lot. Students may not park on the grass, a sidewalk, any road area, or any area NOT assigned with a parking pass. Vehicles parked in the wrong space or in an unauthorized area may receive a citation.
6. Vehicles may NOT be left on campus overnight unless permission has been granted by the administration.
7. The speed limit on campus is NOT to exceed 10 MPH. Drivers and passengers should wear their seat belt. Citations may be issued for a speeding violation or a seat belt violation.
8. Vehicles should be secure at all times. Students are cautioned **NOT** to leave valuables in their vehicles.
9. Students must enter the building upon arriving on campus. Loitering in vehicles or the parking lot may result in a citation.
10. Permission will be granted by the office for a student to return to their vehicle during the school day.
11. Vehicles parked on campus are *subject to search*. This may be done without consent or notification.

White Oak High School is not responsible for damages to or theft from vehicles. Parking a vehicle on campus is a privilege. Students may lose the right to park on campus for a specified period of time or indefinitely for any infraction of these rules or for the improper operation of the vehicle on the school's campus. School disciplinary actions may include the loss of campus parking privileges for a specified time or indefinitely. Students who insist on parking a vehicle on campus following the loss of a parking privilege can expect the vehicle to be removed from campus at the owner's expense.

Driving an automobile represents both a grave responsibility and an alluring temptation. With this in mind, White Oak High School has developed expectations for students when requesting to have a vehicle on campus. The right to have a vehicle on campus is a privilege not a requirement therefore the privilege can be revoked if deemed appropriate by administration.

Eligibility for a parking pass will be determined by presenting the following information to the office: signed and dated WOHS Campus Parking paperwork, a valid NC Driver's license, a valid vehicle registration form in the student's name or the name of a parent, guardian, or other person that has presented a notarized letter giving the student permission to drive the vehicle, clearance of school fees: textbook, media, athletic, band, clubs, or monies owed to the cafeteria.

A payment of \$10.00 per year is required when requesting a parking pass. A replacement fee of \$5.00 will be required for a lost or damaged parking pass. The *hanging* parking pass is to remain in the vehicle that is parked on campus.
