

### Daily Homework Think-Tac-Toe

**Directions:** Read the assigned section and choose one activity to complete for each section. You may use the same activity for each section in the chapter, or choose a different activity for each section. Make sure that you include the key terms and main ideas from the section in your work. \*Note: The first column includes whole chapter activities.

<b>Study Book Mark</b> Make a bookmark by folding a piece of paper lengthwise. On each panel record the key terms and main ideas from one section. By the time you finish reading the section your bookmark should be full.	<b>Graphic Organizer</b> Study the section and decide what thinking map would work best for organizing key terms and main ideas from the section. Fill out your graphic organizer as you read the section. Choose a different map for each section in the chapter.	<b>Interview</b> Write an imaginary interview with a person mentioned in the section. Write the questions you would ask and the response that the person would give to your questions.
<b>Learning Log</b> Make a foldable book (see teacher for instructions) and record your thoughts and feelings as you read the section by answering questions like... What do I already know about the topic? What did I find most interesting? What questions do I have? Who do I admire?....	<b>Story Summary</b> Create a story summary of the section by using the words recorded at the beginning of the section. (about one page)	<b>Writing Focus</b> Complete the writing focus activity at the end of the section. (about one page)
<b>Brochure</b> Create a brochure by folding a piece of paper into thirds. Illustrate the cover and on each panel record key terms and main ideas and include an illustration.	<b>Sequencing</b> Create a flow map or a time line that highlights the major developments of the section.	<b>Analysis</b> Write a question that you think is central to the topic that is open to analysis. Answer your own question in a two or three paragraph essay
