REGISTRATION BLITZ for JUNIORS: *Tuesday, July 27, 2010 from 1:00 to 4:00 P.M. in the café.* All juniors and a parent are to pick up schedules and student ID's, pay fees, fill out paperwork, and have your picture made for the 2011 annual. Enclosed in this mailing is a check-list of information concerning the registration blitz. We hope to complete all beginning of school paperwork and pictures for as many junior students as possible in this one afternoon. We understand that the GHS band will be at band camp that week. If a student has valid reason that prevents them from registering on 7/27/10, **we encourage a parent or family member to still attend the registration.** Schedules may still be picked up, most of the paperwork completed, and fees paid even if the student is unavailable.
