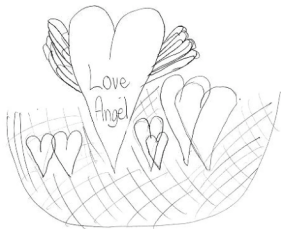

Science Night

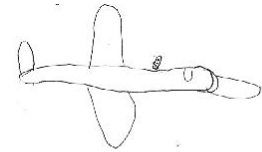
